

- Essex Student Journal (ESJ) is multidisciplinary open access journal
- Launched Autumn 2020, building on Essex's legacy of student publishing
- Library tied ESJ to its open access goals, providing sustainable resources
- Have since worked to increase value for both students and the University

Between 2020 and March 2025:

- 6 PGR students hired as Student Journal Editors
- 75 publications
- 56 student authors
- 186 PGR peer reviewers
